Project 1 Trailer Park Movie

Introduction:

Students are required to apply the basic concepts of the Macromedia Flash basic environment to create an animated movie. This serves the purpose to get the students up to speed in learning the various components of the Flash development platform. Students are also required to practise the use of storyboarding as a multimedia design approach.

Project Objectives:

- To create 2 different storyboards (screen-by-screen plan).
- To choose a storyboard (with better concept) and implement it with Flash.
- To create a Flash movie that introduces users to a show (or shows) at the cinema.
- To display some form of text in the Flash movie.
- To display pictures in the Flash movie.
- To play Sound in the Flash movie.
- To play at least four videos in the Flash movie.
- To allow users to navigate to different videos.
- To show some simple keyframe animation Flash movie.
- To show transitional effects between pictures.
- To control the video played in the Flash movie.

Project Description

What you have to do is to create a Flash movie that introduces users to a show at the cinema like "King Arthur" or "Troy". You may choose to do this in a number of ways:

- As an advertisement for the movie
- As a guide to the characters in the movie
- As a guide to the story of the movie
- Any other idea (check with your lecturer before starting)

Remarks

You may look for other materials on the Web, but don't waste time on this. The priority is to get the movie finished.
